WHAT TO RECYCLE

HOW TO PREPARE

DO NOT INCLUDE

MIXED PAPER PRODUCTS
Boxboard and Mixed Paper

100% PAPER ITEMS
Including boxboard, junk mail, magazines and catalogues without glue bindings, office paper, envelopes, paper egg cartons, toilet paper cores etc

REMOVE ANY PLASTIC LINERS, flatten boxboard. Keep all paper materials together on one side of blue box

× Wax or foil-coated paper, juice boxes, milk, soy cartons, bathroom tissue, paper towels, any 'soiled' paper, wrapping paper (tissue paper), photos, children's artwork (with glue)



CORRUGATED CARDBOARD
(non-waxed)

ALL NON-WAXED CORRUGATED CARDBOARD including packing and shipping boxes, corrugated packing material, etc

CUT DOWN to fit inside box, or neatly tie bundles together. Place beside Blue Box
Maximum 1.2 m Long

× Waxed cardboard, dirty cardboard, cardboard with food debris (soiled portion of pizza boxes are not recyclable)



NEWSPAPER & INSERTS
(non-glossy)

NEWSPAPERS & NEWSPRINT
Including all inserts & flyers that arrive inside your newspaper

PLACE CLEAN NEWSPAPERS & INSERTS IN THE BLUE BOX— Place to one side of the box with other paper materials

× Glossy print pamphlets



METAL
Food & Beverage Cans & Tins

ALL FOOD-GRADE ALUMINUM & STEEL CANS

REMOVE LABELS & RINSE. Flatten where possible. Place tins loosely in the box and set at curb in blue bin

× Aerosol cans, cans that contained hazardous chemicals, scrap metal, hangers, etc.



RIGID PLASTIC Bottles & Containers
(Plastic #1/2/5)

PLASTIC BOTTLES & RIGID CONTAINERS
With the 1/2/5 numbered symbol on bottom

REMOVE & DISCARD LIDS. Rinse bottles and squash or flatten (if possible)

× Any plastic container without a # on the bottom, Styrofoam, motor oil containers, containers that contained hazardous materials.



SOFT PLASTICS & FILM
(Plastic #4)

PLASTIC BAGS AND FILM
With the 4 numbered symbol on bottom

ENSURE ALL BAGS AND FILM ARE CLEAN AND FREE OF FOOD WASTE. PLACE IN PLASTIC GROCERY BAG AND TIE OFF

× Any soft plastic/plastic film that has food debris or any other debris
